2 Corinthians

Acts

"Far more imprisonments.",

Prior to Paul's final trip to Jerusalem, Acts has one imprisonment that lasted half the night (Acts 16:19-40).

"Five times I have received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one." Acts records zero instances of lashing.

"Three times I have been beaten with rods" (summary punishment by a Roman magistrate)

One time is mentioned in 16:22.

"Once I received a stoning."

Acts 14:19 describes a stoning.

"Three times was I shipwrecked; for a night and a day I was adrift at sea."

Acts does not mention shipwreck prior to Paul's journey from Caesarea to Rome.

"Hungry and thirsty, often without food, cold and naked."

This is not mentioned in Acts.
